PARTICULARS OF PROGRAMMES

ARTS SCIENCE COMMERCE & MANAGEMENT STUDIES

The courses offered by our college are under the semester system with Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) introduced by the Government of Tamil Nadu for UG & PG Courses. For all the UG courses, Part I is Tamil / Malayalam / Hindi, and Part II is Communicative English, Part III consists of Major and two Allied subjects. During the first and second year of the study, Skill Based Courses and Non-Major Elective Courses, Extension activities, Yoga and Computer for digital era are taught in addition to the major subjects. The students have to opt any one of the extra-curricular activities viz. NSS, NCC, Physical Education or YRC as a part of their study under Part V. The college has six units of NSS which focus on service-oriented activities. As far as the NCC is concerned, there is a unit consisting of boys and girls. - ❖ Admissions will be made as per the Government norms.
- ❖ 50% of the total seats will be reserved under minority quota for the community which runs the college.
- ❖ 6 seats for UG programmes & 3 seats for PG programmes shall be reserved for the children of ex-servicemen of Tamil Nadu origin.
- ❖ 3% of seats for sports persons in UG and 2% of seats for sports persons in PG is reserved for the candidates who have represented in District (Revenue) / Divisional and above level on production of relevant certificates.
- ❖ 5% of seats is reserved for Differently Abled Students.
- ❖ One seat in UG programme shall be reserved for NCC 'A' certificate holder and one seat in PG programme for 'C' certificate holder in NCC.
- ❖ Photo copy of the community certificate issued by the Tamil Nadu Govt. must be attached with the application and the original is to be shown at the time of interview. This certificate is not mandatory for the candidates who belong to the forward community.
- ❖ For admission to UG programmes except B.A. Tamil & B.A. English ranking will be based on the marks obtained in part III in HSC out of 400 marks. For B.A. Tamil Literature Part I Tamil marks and for B.A English Literature Part II English marks will only be considered for the ranking.
- ❖ For admission to all PG programmes (Except MBA and MCA), the marks of the qualifying examination (Major and Allied) alone shall be taken into consideration.

معر **AGE LIMIT FOR ADMISSION TO UG PROGRAMMES** معر

The upper age limit for admission to Under Graduate programmes is 21 (twenty-one years) as on 1st July 2023.

ELIGIBILITY FOR UG, PG & M.Phil. PROGRAMMES

- UG : Pass in HSC. in State Board / CBSE / ISC / IGCSE
- M.Sc. : 50% marks in the qualifying examination.
- M.Com. : Pass in B.Com. or B.A. Corporate Secretaryship.
- M.B.A. : Any UG Degree with 50% Marks.
- M.C.A. : Any UG Degree with 50% marks in Science or 45% marks in Arts. (Mathematics should be one of the subjects in HSC. / UG.)
- M.Phil. : 55% Marks in PG and should qualify the eligibility test conducted by M.S. University.

LAST DATE FOR SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION FORM

Application form duly filled in all respects should reach the Principal within 10 working days after the publication of the results of the +2 Examination / UG / PG Degree examination and should be enclosed with the photo copies of the following:

1. HSC/UG/PG mark sheet.
2. Transfer Certificate from the Institution where the student has studied last.
3. Conduct Certificate from the Institution last studied.
4. Community Certificate (if applicable).
5. Certificate for Children of Ex-Servicemen (if applicable).
6. Certificate for Differently Abled Candidates (if applicable).
7. Games / Sports / NCC / NSS / Proficiency Certificates (National / State / Inter-District level only) (if applicable).
8. Church Membership Certificate (for CSI candidates of Kanniyakumari Diocese).
9. Blood group Certificate.
10. Annual income Certificate.
11. Aadhar Card

The names of students selected for the counselling /interview will be displayed on the notice board. All the students have to attend the counselling as per the schedule given by the college and the candidate should bring his / her father or mother (if father is not alive) at the time of interview. All the original certificates including the mark sheet have to be produced at the time of interview, failing which they forfeit their seats.

Admission is subject to the verification of the mark statements by the Director of Government Examination and if their mark statement is found to be bogus, admission is liable for cancellation, besides criminal action taken against them. At the time of admission, all students, including fee concession holders except SC / ST candidates, should pay the first instalment of the tuition fee (PG), Science fee and Special fee.

FEES

- ❖ For all programmes, fee will be charged as per the Government norms.
- ❖ For all first-year students (Aided & SF) entrance fee of Rs. 100/-, recognition fee of Rs. 100/-, admission fee Rs. 5/-, HSC certificate verification fee of Rs. 50/- for each certificate, Flag Day fund of Rs. 51/- Youth Red Cross Society fee of Rs. 20/-, NSS fee of Rs. 10/- and Re. 1 for Harijan Seva Sangam will be collected.

- ❖ Special fees include fee for Library, Games, Medical, Stationery for Examinations, Associations, Magazine, College day, Calendar, World University Services, Student Services, Campus Amenity, Visual Education etc.
- ❖ Any student (SF) who leaves the course in the middle must pay the entire fees and the fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- ❖ A student, who leaves after he / she is admitted, will have to pay the fees for the full year before he / she gets back his / her certificates.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ The original certificates will not be returned to the candidate before the completion of the programme. Hence applicants are advised to take sufficient number of photo copies of the same before admission.
- ❖ If the mark sheet is found to be bogus, the admission will be cancelled and criminal action will be initiated.
- ❖ Students should be well behaved inside and outside the college premises.
- ❖ The cleanliness and safety of the college buildings and property are the responsibility of every student.
- ❖ Students are very strictly warned not to indulge in Eve-teasing or Ragging.
- ❖ Cell phone is prohibited inside the campus for the students.
- ❖ Wearing of full uniform is compulsory for both boys and girls in all working days except on the last working day of a month.
- ❖ Wearing of jeans pants or low hip pants is strictly prohibited.
