





Analysis of the Feedback

513 students took part in this feedback data collection, out of which 85% were female and 15 % male.

90% of the students had the opinion that the programme outcomes and course outcomes are in tune with the prescribed syllabus. They feel that the curriculum offers scope for the inclusion of learner's ideas. About 87% of the respondents feel that there is scope for self-learning and the methodology used for teaching is suitable for the course content. But only 73% of the students feel that social, environment and gender issues are addressed in the curriculum. Again a significant number of 15 % of the students had no opinion for the evaluation method employed by the university where 82 % of them felt that the evaluation method is suitable for the courses.


Action Taken Report

Overall, the students had a good opinion about the curriculum framed by the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University. They felt that that there is scope for self-learning and the methodology used for teaching is suitable for the course content. But only 73% of the students feel that social, environment and gender issues are addressed in the curriculum. Hence more cross cutting issues need to be integrated into the curriculum. It was presented to the heads of departments and the members of the Board of Studies to present this in the University meetings to revamp the curriculum.




Does the curriculum enable you to master/understand the subject well? 21 responses
