## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Online registration is mandatory.
- A registration Fee of Rs. 50/- per participant, per event, must be paid on the day of the event.
- A student can participate in only one competition per session.
- College identity card and a bonafide certificate must be produced.
- A participation ID will be issued and no participant will be allowed inside the campus without an ID card.
- Lunch will be provided.
- The host college will not participate.
- Vulgarity in any form and inflammable materials are strictly prohibited.
- Participants must maintain strict discipline inside the campus.
- Participants are requested to bring the songs for the dance on a pendrive and submit it at the registration counter.
- Participants are instructed to bring the properties and materials required for the competition.
- The college scoring the maximum points will be awarded the **Overall championship and a cash prize of Rs. 15,000/-**
- The runner-up will receive the **Ever rolling trophy and a cash prize of Rs. 10,000/-**
- An Ever-rolling trophy for each event will be awarded to the college that wins the first prize.
- Individual prizes and certificates will be awarded to the winners.
- The Judges' decision will be final.
