GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. All students must carry either a Bonafide Certificate from the school or a school ID Card.
2. Only students studying in government and government-aided schools are eligible to participate in the competitions.
3. In each category, only one individual participant or one team from each school can participate in each competition.
4. The competitions held over the two days are divided into five sessions. A student is permitted to participate in only one competition per session. Therefore, a student can participate in a maximum of five competitions, one in each session.
5. All competitions will be conducted separately for Middle School, High School and Higher Secondary School students. Prizes will be awarded to the top three in all competitions. Trophies will be awarded to the top two schools with the highest overall points.
6. All students participating in the competitions must compulsorily register through the Google Form. Last date for Registration is 10.10.2026. Spot registration is not allowed.
7. Participants must bring all the materials required for the respective competition. The organisers will provide only the sheets required for drawing and writing competitions.
8. Pre-prepared works or creations are not permitted in the competitions.
9. Participants must report to the competition venue at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start time.
10. The use of mobile phones and electronic devices is prohibited during the competitions.
11. Only decent, appropriate performances or works suitable for school students that promote social awareness and social responsibility will be accepted.
12. The judges' decision shall be final.
13. The organisers reserve the right to make necessary changes to the rules or arrangements to ensure the smooth conduct of the competitions.

- Late comers will not be allowed.
- All competitions will be conducted separately for Middle school (MS), High School (HS) & Higher Secondary School (H.Sc)
